

Bus Timetable Changes Coming into Effect from 7 September 2026

Following two rounds of public consultation, the Committee has approved a package of timetable changes designed to improve reliability, maintain access to key destinations, enhance hospital connectivity and improved evening and night bus provision across the Island.

From 7 September 2026, bus passengers will benefit from more frequent services on Routes 51 and 52, enhanced links to the Princess Elizabeth Hospital, additional summer Sunday services, improved evening provision following the withdrawal of the S services, and a revised night bus network providing better overnight coverage across the Island.

Better Connections to Key Community Destinations

Enhanced Routes 51 and 52

Routes 51 and 52 have been redesigned as new circular Town services, providing improved links between key community destinations including Guernsey Harbour, Beau Sejour, Les Ozouets Campus, Footes Lane, Les Varendes High School and the Princess Elizabeth Hospital (PEH).

Following the original public consultation, concerns were raised regarding the loss of early morning connections to both the PEH and Les Varendes High School. In response to this feedback, additional early morning journeys have been reinstated as part of the final approved timetable, helping to maintain access for hospital staff, patients and students.

The routes will now operate via Les Ozouets, Foote's Lane, Les Baissieres, Rue du Friquet and Rectory Hill, providing improved access for students, patients, visitors and workers.

Key Improvements:

- Routes 51 and 52 will now operate **hourly throughout the day, Monday to Saturday**, representing a significant enhancement from the previous **two-hourly frequency**.
- Route 21 has been amended on both inbound and outbound routes to provide services via Town and Le Grand Bouet.

Improved Access to the PEH

Routes 93 and 94 Retained and Enhanced

Following consultation feedback, particularly from Alderney residents travelling to hospital appointments, the original proposal to discontinue Route 94 was not approved.

Instead:

- Route 93 remains on its existing two-hourly timetable.

- Route 94 remains on its existing two-hourly timetable.
- Both routes will now directly serve the PEH via Oberlands, replacing the link previously provided by Route 71.

This maintains an important Airport to PEH connection and provides increased hospital access from the south-west of the Island.

Enhanced Sunday Services

Routes 91 and 92

Additional Sunday services have been approved during the summer season (start of the May half term to the end of School Summer Holidays) to provide greater flexibility and improve access around the Island.

Additional Route 91 departures: 10:05, 12:05, 14:05, 16:05, 18:05

Additional Route 92 departures: 10:35, 12:35, 14:35, 16:35

Maintaining Important Community Links

Route 61

Following concerns raised during consultation, Route 61 has been revised to retain connectivity to communities, including areas previously served by the Route 60.

The inbound journey will now operate via:

Le Coudre, Longfrie, Le Frie Baton, La Grande Rue, Rue du Perelle, Route de la Perelle, Rue de la Maladerie, Route de la Margion, Vazon Road and Rue du Gele before rejoining its existing route.

Evening Service Changes

The S1-S4 evening services will be withdrawn and replaced with later journeys on existing routes.

Replacement evening journeys include:

- 20:30 and 21:00 Monday to Friday.
- 20:20 Sunday.

Route 13

- 20:15 and 20:45 Monday to Friday.

- 19:45 Sunday.

Route 41

- 20:30 Monday to Friday.

- 20:15 and 20:45 Monday to Friday.
- 20:30 Sunday.

Route 61

- New 20:10 journey daily.

Route 71

- New 20:10 journey Monday to Friday.
- New 20:05 journey Saturday.

Route 93

- New 20:35 journey Monday to Friday.

Route 94

- New 20:35 journey Monday to Friday.

Service Withdrawals and Reductions

The following changes form part of the approved package:

P2 Parish Link

- Service withdrawn due to low passenger demand.

Route 60

- Service withdrawn.

Route 71

- Route shortened and will no longer serve the Airport (except for the retained morning and afternoon extended services).

Early Morning Service Withdrawals

The consultation documents also included the removal of a number of lightly used early morning services, including:

- Route 11 at 05:30 Monday to Friday.

- Route 32 at 07:35 Saturday.
- Route 61 at 05:10 Monday to Friday.

Note: I have not found evidence in the approved consultation documents available to me that a Route 11 08:30 service was removed. The documents I accessed specifically reference removal of the 05:30 Monday to Friday Route 11 journey.

Improved Night Bus Network

All four night bus services have been revised to improve overnight coverage across the Island.

Route N1

The current Route N1 has been extended slightly to cover the Rue Sauvage and Les Tracheries area.

Route N2

This service has been amended and will serve the Rohais, L'Aumone, Saumarez Park, Route de Carteret, Rue de la Saline (Cobo), Route de la Mare de Carteret, Port Soif, Portinfer and Pleinheume.

Route N3

The current Route N3 has been extended from L'Eree to serve Perelle, the south end of Vazon and the Frie Baton.

Route N4

The current outbound route N4 will remain the same until Les Buttes, then head to Kings Mills, Route du Cobo, Vazon, Beaucamp and Bailiff's Cross Road.

Route-by-Route Summary of Final Approved Bus Timetable Changes

Effective from 7 September 2026

This summary reflects the final approved package following both rounds of consultation and highlights the changes most likely to affect passengers.

P2 Parish Link

- Service withdrawn due to low passenger usage.
- Alternative coverage available via nearby services, including Routes 12, 51 and 52.

Route 11

- No route change.

- Early morning **05:30 Monday to Friday** journey removed.
- Additional evening journeys introduced to replace withdrawn S services:
 - 20:30 Monday to Friday
 - 21:00 Monday to Friday
 - 20:20 Sunday.

Route 12

- Outbound route amended to operate via La Route des Coutures, Croix du Bois and Maraitaine Road instead of La Route du Braye and Sohier Road.
- The 06:15 Monday to Friday Route 12 journey from Town will be withdrawn and replaced by a new journey commencing at The Bridge at approximately 06:30
- Additional early morning inbound provision retained following consultation feedback.

Route 13

- No route changes.
- Additional evening journeys introduced:
 - 20:15 Monday to Friday
 - 20:45 Monday to Friday.
 - 19:45 Sunday

Route 21

- Revised routing via Admiral Park and Le Grand Bouet.
- Outbound journeys travel through Admiral Park and Le Grand Bouet before returning to the Seafront.
- Inbound journeys route via Le Grand Bouet and Admiral Park before returning to the Seafront.

Routes 31 and 32

- Early morning **07:35 Saturday** journey removed

Route 41

- No route amendment.
- New evening journeys:
 - 20:30 Monday to Friday
 - 20:00 Sunday.

Route 42

- No route amendment.
- New evening journeys:
 - 20:15 and 20:45 Monday to Friday
 - 20:30 Sunday.

Routes 51 and 52

The most significant daytime service enhancements within the network.

Route 51

- Realigned via Guernsey Harbour and Beau Sejour.
- Operates via: Guernsey Harbour Beau Sejour, Les Ozouets, Foote's Lane, Les Baissieres, Rue du Friquet, Rectory Hill, PEH.

Route 52

- Reverse of Route 51 alignment.

Routes 51 and 52 will now operate **hourly throughout the day, Monday to Saturday**, representing a significant enhancement from the previous **two-hourly frequency**.

Route 60

- Service withdrawn.

Route 61

- Early morning **05:10 Monday to Friday** journey removed.
- New 20:10 evening journey daily.
- Inbound route amended via: Le Coudre, Longfrie, Le Frie Baton, La Grande Rue, Rue du Perelle, Route de la Perelle, Rue de la Maladerie, Route de la Margion, Vazon Road, Rue du Gele.

Route 71

- Route shortened and will no longer serve the Airport (except for the retained morning and afternoon extended services).
- New evening journeys:
 - 20:10 Monday to Friday
 - 20:05 Saturday.

Route 81

- No changes.

Route 91

- Enhanced Sunday summer service with additional departures at: 10:05, 12:05, 14:05, 16:05, 18:05.

Route 92

Route 93

- Retained on existing two-hourly timetable following consultation feedback.
- Amended to directly serve the PEH via Oberlands.
- Additional 20:35 Monday to Friday journey introduced replacing former S3 provision.

Route 94

- Retained on existing two-hourly timetable rather than being withdrawn.
- Amended to directly serve the PEH via Oberlands.
- Maintains Airport to PEH connectivity for Alderney residents travelling for hospital appointments.

Route 95

- Additional 20:20 and 20:50 Monday to Friday journeys
- Additional 19:20, 19:50, 20:20 and 20:50 Sunday journeys

Evening S Services

S1, S2, S3 and S4

- All services withdrawn.
- Replacement journeys incorporated into Routes 11, 13, 41, 42, 61, 71 and 93.

N3

Revised route servicing: Le Bordage, La Charroterie, Martin's Village, Airport, Torteval Church, Pleinmont, L'Eree, Perelle Bay, Vazon Road, Rue du Gele, Frie Baton, Longfrie St Martin's Village, La Charroterie, Le Bordage.

N4

Revised route servicing: The Grange, Queens Road, Le Vauquiedor, St Andrew's Church, Little Chapel, Route des Bas Courtils, St Saviour's Church, King's Mills Road, Route de Cobo, Cobo Bay, Vazon Bay, Rue des Eturs, Bailiff's Cross, Le Vauquiedor, Queens Road, The Grange.
