A general Question and Answer session was held with the Deputies.

- 1. Minutes of the Meeting held on September 24th 2018, were approved by the Douzaine.
- 2. Matters arising None.
- 3. 2 Bornements were approved.
- 4. Parish Elections To be held at the Vale Douzaine Room on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018 at 7-30pm.
- 5. Impact of Referendum. No further information has been received in connection with procedures for Island Wide Voting.
- 6. Update on Remembrance Day. Booklets on the service men have now been printed and the service sheets produced. A request for Route du Couture to be closed to traffic for the duration of the service will be made.
- 7. Website Report. User numbers are still increasing with many return users.
- 8. Hedge and Streams inspections have been carried out for the year with the majority being successfully completed. Letters have been sent to those where issues have arisen.
- 9. Waste meeting report. After the first four weeks of the new waste strategy, 200 tonnes of food waste has been collected, black bags are down and an extra 55 tonnes of blue/white bag recycling has been collected. A decision is to be made for reflective stickers to be used on the black food caddies and new stickers produced for uncollected bags. Few complaints are now received about the glass collections. Amendments to charges and self-catering units is to be discussed in the States. The waste disposal site is to be commissioned by the end of October and handed to the States of Guernsey by the end of the year. The green waste tip will be moving to Mont Cuet and Dog waste bins are being removed and replaced with general waste bins.
