1. Minutes of the Meeting held on April 29th 2019, were approved by the Douzaine.
2. Matters arising –
  - a) Letter sent re Saltpans Development. No reply has been received as yet.
  - b) RD advised a reply had been received from Mr C McCleod of the CO-OP concerning Leale's Yard.
3. Bornements – Two were approved.
4. Hedges and Streams Inspections. Dates and times were agreed by the Douzeniers for carrying out the inspections. Douzeniers have also been asked to note any road names that need replacing and any road that is in disrepair.
5. Correspondence. One request was made for an event next year.
6. Any other Business –
  - a) A letter has been requested to be sent to the Channel Island Air Search to wish them well.
  - b) On-road parking is becoming an issue in Les Grand Marais.
  - c) A query was raised concerning the removal of the disabled parking bays outside the opticians on the Bridge. Traffic and Highways have moved the two disabled bays to the middle of the Bridge and one has been placed outside the computer shop.
  - d) When is the playground equipment going to be installed? As soon as safety stipulations have been received from the manufacturer. Picnic benches are being installed at Rouse and benches at Chouet and the quarry field behind the Douzaine room.

- e) Youngsters have been reported riding scooters on the pavements at the Bridge.
- f) A complaint had been made about the traffic lights at Bulwer Avenue and Admiral Park. Traffic and Highways have replied and problem should now be fixed.
