A general Question and Answer session was held with the Deputies.

1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 15th June 2020, were approved by the Douzaine after an adjustment requested by JS.
2. Matters arising –
  - a) Street Lighting. Request for information from Guernsey Electricity on LED street lighting is still outstanding.
  - b) Beaucette Road Closure. The barriers installed by the Fire Brigade before Christmas have now been removed.
  - c) Hougue Jehannet. Barriers have been installed at Summerfield Road end and the Northside end are supposed to be closed every night, however they are not. The Constables have given permission for our letter from the Douzaine to be included in the Policy Letter.
  - d) Bridge Street Lights. A joint decision was made with St Sampson's Douzaine on new street lamps for the Bridge.
  - e) Meeting with Dawn Tindall. A date is still to be set.
3. Bornements – six bornements were approved.
4. General Election. Pre-polling will be available at St Sampson's High School and The Princess Royal Performing Arts Centre on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> October 2020 with Parish voting available on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020. Postal votes for this election can also be put in the ballot boxes on polling days. A request for volunteers was made.
5. Streams and Hedges. The inspections for June have mainly been successful with just 3 streams outstanding and 1 hedge.

6. Correspondence.

- a) A Quevatre put forward a proposal for a traffic restriction on Rue de L'Essart.
- b) Guernsey Marathon – 20<sup>th</sup> October 2020 – Approved.

7. Any Other Business.

- a) RL asked for volunteers for the Parochial Appeals Panel.
- b) BC advised the first piece of equipment has now been installed at the playground.
