1. Minutes of the Meeting held by zoom on 22nd February 2021, were approved by the Douzaine.
2. Matters arising
 - Update on Douit – Braye Road Clos. A retrospective planning application has been submitted for fencing on top of the wall. RH advised that douits should be 2' wide whereas the width of this is now 18". PvdT suggested the douit could be piped. The douzaine have also been advised that all properties should have left 6' between their boundaries and the douit. RL will write to Planning Department again.
3. Bornements – One bornement was approved.
4. Braye Road Development – Draft Framework. RL outlined the development and will be writing to the Planning Department highlighting issues such as the douit and vehicular access.
