1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 24th May 2021 were approved.
2. Matters Arising. D. Dudley-Owen – L’Ancrese kiosk concession. Approval has been given and will be investigating having buoys in the bay.

4. DLG Working Party. Pvd and JS will be representing the Vale douzaine in the hope they will be selected by H. Soulsby.
5. Update on Parochial Rates. There are still 240 accounts outstanding totalling approximately £46,000 still owed.
6. Hedge and Streams inspections. More letters than normal have been sent out this year, however most cantons have now been cut.
7. Meeting with St Sampsons re Infrastructure Plan Initiative. P.Ferbrache declined to attend this meeting, therefore no further action will be taken.
8. Data Protection Seminar 16th June. GC and BC attended this informative presentation given by M. Harrison. The Constables Office was registered earlier in the year. It was approved by the Douzaine that addresses of Douzeniers would be removed from the website.
