- 1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 28th June 2021 were approved.
- 2. Matters Arising.
 - Bridge Lamp posts. New lampposts have been chosen for the Bridge area. They are galvanised then painted, are LED and dimmable to reduce light pollution. Lights may be strung between the posts permanently removing the cost of scaffolding. The cost will be split between Vale and St Sampson. St Sampson's Douzaine will discuss at their September meeting to give Guernsey Electricity an answer by the end of that month.
 - PvdT was chosen to be the Vale representative on the new Douzaine Liaison Group and their first meeting will be in September.
- 3. Bornements. Seven Bornements were approved.
- 4. Planning Application at Les Amarreurs. The Douzaine was split on this application with safety being a main concern. The two beaches and playground are well used with the roads and car parks full. Notices have already been put in place requesting the laybys not be used for parking.
- 5. St Sampson re Infrastructure Plan Initiative. A response has been received from Deputy Soulsby and St Sampson's Douzaine will discuss and respond.
- 6. Parish Elections 4th August. Three candidates will be standing. Nigel Leale, Anne Setters and Mary Lowe.
- 7. Report re Planning Exemptions PvdT and RD. There were 68 exemptions on the list with most enhancing what is in place already.
- 8. Correspondence.
 - Planning Service application re Braye Clos stream. A response has been received with no will to resolve the issue.

- Committee for E & I insurance re parish moorings. Will be forwarded for all Douzaines to discuss.
