2. Matters Arising.
 - Bridge Lamp posts. The cost will be split between the Vale and St Sampson. No further information from Guernsey Electricity.

 - Queen's Platinum Jubilee. A joint committee is to be set up with St Sampson's Douzaine.
 - A meeting was held with Paul Fletcher regarding "Solarizing Guernsey". This was an informative evening.

8. Waste contractor's meeting. A survey will be run until 6th October. ACLMS deals with cliff/roadside rubbish with all reports to go through Guernsey Waste. GW running a love-your-caddy campaign to try and encourage less replacements and have recently performed a

bag contamination survey with around 200 houses. Washing of contents to prevent contamination could be improved. There are no changes to collections this Christmas/New Year.
