## **DELIBERATION**

The Electors of the Parish of the Vale have met at the Douzaine Room on this 3rd November 2021 for the election of Two Constables, Four Douzeniers and Three Members of the Parochial Cemetery Committee,

The Meeting was opened by the Dean of the Douzaine and Richard Leale led the opening prayer.

APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE – Stuart Tanswell, Sue Earles, Jon Bond, Gill Fallaize, Denise Cohu and Michelle le Clerc.

The Dean read the publication regarding the election of the two Constables and the Senior Constable read the publication regarding the election of the four Douzeniers, the three Members of the Parochial Cemetery Committee and the other items on the Agenda.

### **ELECTION OF TWO CONSTABLES**

As the number of nominations received did not exceed the number of vacancies, and the requirements of the Law being duly observed, the Returning Officer, Miss Rosemary Henry, declared Mr Richard Alan Leale and Mr William Harold Cohu re-elected to the office of Constable.

### **ELECTION OF FOUR DOUZENIERS**

As the number of nominations received did not exceed the number of vacancies, and the requirements of the Law being duly observed, the Returning Officer, Mr Richard Leale declared, Miss Rosemary Anne Henry, Terence Ives Ashworth, Jonathan Bond and Anne Bernadette Setters elected to the office of Douzenier.

### **For the office of member of the Vale Primary Parochial School Committee (3 seats)**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Janet Edith de Jersey, Gillian Anne Fallaize and Nina Jane Gill were elected.

### **For the office of member of the Haute Capelles Primary Parochial School Committee (2 seats)**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mary May Lowe and Paul Ferbrache Van Der Tang were elected.

### **For the office of member of the Baubigny Parochial School Committee (2 seats)**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Michelle Karen Le Clerc and Anne Bernadette Setters were elected.

**For the office of member of the La Mare de Carteret Primary Parochial School Committee (1 seat to complete the term to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022**

No nominations were received.

**THREE MEMBERS FOR THE VALE PAROCHIAL CEMETERY COMMITTEE.**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mrs Shirley Elizabeth Banyard, Mrs Denise Cohu and Nigel John Leale were elected.

At this point Brian de Jersey stood and thanked Wilson Le Page for his 30 years of service on the committee, 24 of those as president. All those present gave a round of applause.

**For the office of member of the Vale Parish Church Property Management Board (2 seats)**

Jeremy Smithies proposed Colin Smith and André Quevatre seconded. Dave Bradshaw proposed Francis Le Tissier and Jeremy Smithies seconded. Colin Smith and Francis Le Tissier were elected.

**BY THE ELECTORS AND RATEPAYERS**

- a) RL asked the meeting for approval to continue with Messrs. Collenette Jones as Auditors for the Constables Accounts for 2020 and this was approved.
- b) To fix the time at which Parish Meetings shall be held in 2022. It was agreed to start at 7-30p.m. – the Meeting Approved.
- c) To take all measures as the Electors and Ratepayers have deemed advisable, viz:
  - Richard Leale informed the Meeting that the Remembrance Day Service is to be held at the War memorial starting at 10am on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November and should last approximately 15 to 20 minutes.
  - Brian de Jersey asked if there had been any progress with the “closed for risk” Hougue Jehannet road. RL informed the meeting that the Douzaine had received correspondence from Dep. Roffey of States Trading Supervisory Board that they were not in favour of the closure and had passed it back to Guernsey Electricity to ask the Douzaine to request a public meeting to discuss. The Douzaine had written to Guernsey Electricity 3-4 weeks ago but had not received a reply. Mary Lowe stated that Guernsey Electricity wanted it closed for 7 years, but asked who had the final say and how long would the Douzaine wait for a reply. RL reiterated that GE has to ask the Douzaine to call the public meeting and advised that St Peter Port douzaine had gone through the same issue which went to the States of Guernsey who still kept that road closed. Brian de Jersey informed that the same issue arose 28 years ago with the tip road. RL advised the GE and STSB cannot agree and that GE were hiding behind the emergency temporary closure and it would be nice to know what the emergency is. RL also advised that cabling to the whole island is under the road. ML asked for a report to go on the parish website and RL said he would write again to GE. C Smith told the meeting that the public want it sorted which RL replied that the douzaine was aware.
  - Mary Lowe was disgusted and very disappointed that no nominees had been received for the La Mare de Carteret Primary school committee position and that they will be let down without any representation from the Vale.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 7.45 p.m.
