**2. Matters arising.**

- Goal Nets. The douzaine will buy their own nets for on the common.
- Hougue Jehannet. The road is still closed under emergency legislation. If the power station site is reconfigured in the future, then the road may be returned as part of the public highway.

**7. Parish rates.** 4719 were issued on 1<sup>st</sup> June. There are 512 outstanding.

**8. Correspondence.**

- Waste. The WDA waste bill should be sent out at the beginning of August and will be for £97-97. Any questions from parishioners should be directed to the HUB and their details are on the invoices.
- Playground at Amarreurs. This will be repainted and new safety matting will replace the existing matting. Work is likely to start near the end of September.
- Folklore trail. An email was received advising that a Folklore trail is to be created around the island. There will be sign boards with QR codes to download stories and leaflets at each designated area, some of which are in the Vale.
- Dangerous parking – new yellow line. Due to parking on pavements and blocking sight lines, a new yellow line will be painted from The Roost Clos down to the Braye Road.

**9. Any other Business.**

- The women of the douzaine have been invited to the “Women in Public Life” event to be held on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> August.
