- 1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 24th June** were approved by the Douzaine.
- 2. Matters arising:**
 - **Playground Update** - We are just waiting for the large swing set to be replaced and the surface laid underneath otherwise all surfaces have been replaced and feel very springy underfoot.
